## DAY ONE OF THE INTERNATIONAL ANTI-CORRUPTION DAY COMMEMORATION



The Public Service Commission (PSC) in partnership with the United Nations in South Africa and the University of South Africa holds a two day event to commemorate the 2022 International Anti-Corruption Day from 08-09 December 2022. The theme for the event is ***"The Cost of Failure of Governance, Ethics and Oversight: A collective response to tackle the scourge of corruption in the Public Sector"***.

The first day of the conference, took the form of a panel discussion comprising of representatives from the Forum for Institutions Supporting Democracy. The discussions focused on the following amongst others:

- Building Ethical Governance: The Judicial Commission of Inquiry into Allegations of State Capture, Corruption and Fraud in the Public Service and how it implicates Institutions Supporting Democracy.
- Renewed Commitment to Fight Corruption: Creating institutional checks and balances to hold political leaders and public officials accountable to the citizens for their actions.

The event was attended by amongst others, Principals of the Forum for Institutions Supporting Democracy, Diplomatic Corps, Academia, public servants, selected Business and Civil Society members and Commissioners from the Public Service Commission.

The theme of the conference is ***“Uprooting Corruption, Defending Democratic Values”***.
